hardison/downey donates services to Gallery@City Hall
New space features rotating exhibits from Phoenix's art collection

PHOENIX (March 12, 2012) – hardison/downey construction inc. (h/d) played a significant role in building out the new Gallery @ City Hall, a new art gallery that features rotating exhibitions at Phoenix City Hall.

As a nearly entirely pro-bono project, h/d donated its services to ensure the space was ready for its inaugural exhibit, which celebrates the cultural legacy that Phoenix residents began building nearly a century ago.

The space features rotating exhibitions from the city's historic and contemporary art collection, and is free and open to the public from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Friday.

The city's collection includes historic paintings by leading American painters from the first half of the 20th century; photography by prominent 20th century American photographers; a 63-piece collection of works by Native American artists; historic etchings by George Elbert Burr; extensive limited-edition prints by modern American artists; and several series of themed works in mixed media. The gallery is presented by the Phoenix Arts and Culture Commission and the City of Phoenix Office of Arts and Culture.

h/d is one of approximately 40 businesses and residents that contributed to the privately funded effort.
